Background on the Gospel Reading

Today's Gospel concludes three weeks of readings from the 13th Chapter of Matthew's Gospel. Throughout these three weeks we have heard Jesus teaching crowds about the kingdom of heaven, and we have heard Jesus interpret some of his teachings for the disciples. In this week's Gospel, Jesus offers three more short parables.

The first two parables describe the great value of the kingdom of heaven. In the first parable, Jesus says that the kingdom of heaven is like a buried treasure that is worth possessing even if it means giving up everything else. In the second parable, Jesus proposes that the kingdom of heaven is like a pearl of great worth for which one will sell everything else to possess. These parables teach us that we are to place everything we value in the service of the pursuit of the Kingdom of God.

The third parable that Jesus proposes in today's Gospel is different from the first two, but it is reminiscent of the parable of the sower heard in last week's Gospel. The kingdom of heaven is compared to fishing with a wide net. After the fish have been collected, the good fish are kept and the bad fish are thrown away; so too, in the final judgment, will the wicked and the righteous be separated.

Today's Gospel concludes with a curious statement about the scribe who understands the kingdom of heaven. Here a metaphor is offered: this scribe is like the head of a household who "brings from his storeroom both the new and the old." The scribes referred to here are experts of Mosaic law. It is possible that Jesus is here instructing the early Christian community on how to proceed in the interpretation of Jewish law with respect to Jesus' "new" teaching. Jesus' teaching about the kingdom of heaven does not replace the Jewish tradition; it interprets it in a different light.

Contexto de la lectura del Evangelio

El Evangelio de hoy concluye tres semanas de lecturas del capítulo 13 del Evangelio de Mateo. A lo largo de estas tres semanas, hemos escuchado a Jesús enseñar a las multitudes sobre el Reino de los Cielos e interpretar algunas de sus enseñanzas para los discípulos. En el Evangelio de esta semana, Jesús presenta tres parábolas breves más.

Las dos primeras parábolas describen el gran valor del Reino de los Cielos. En la primera, Jesús dice que el Reino de los Cielos es como un tesoro escondido que vale la pena poseer, aunque ello implique renunciar a todo lo demás. En la segunda parábola, Jesús plantea que el Reino de los Cielos es como una perla de gran valor, por la cual uno vendería todo lo demás para adquirirla. Estas parábolas nos enseñan que debemos poner todo lo que valoramos al servicio de la búsqueda del Reino de Dios.

La tercera parábola que Jesús presenta en el Evangelio de hoy es distinta de las dos primeras, pero recuerda a la parábola del sembrador, escuchada en el Evangelio de la semana pasada. El Reino de los Cielos se compara con la pesca con una red grande. Una vez recogida la pesca, se conservan los peces buenos y se desechan los malos; del mismo modo, en el juicio final, serán separados los malvados de los justos.

El Evangelio de hoy concluye con una afirmación curiosa sobre el escriba que comprende el Reino de los Cielos. Aquí se ofrece una metáfora: este escriba es como el dueño de una casa que «saca de su despensa tanto lo nuevo como lo viejo». Los escribas a los que se hace referencia aquí son expertos en la ley mosaica. Es posible que Jesús esté instruyendo a la comunidad cristiana primitiva sobre cómo proceder en la interpretación de la ley judía a la luz de su «nueva» enseñanza. La enseñanza de Jesús sobre el Reino de los Cielos no reemplaza la tradición judía, sino que la interpreta bajo una luz diferente.
